Reminder – Municipal Election – May 9th

Hamilton –May 8th, 2019

The City of Hamilton reminds the public that the municipal election in Hamilton will take place on Thursday, May 9th. Only those business rate-payers who registered to vote in the municipal election may cast a ballot. The polling station is located at the Seventh Day Adventist Church on King Street and will be open from 8am till 8pm. Free parking for voters will be available in the King Street parking lot next to the church. Businesses may check their registration status by visiting the Parliamentary Registrar's website at www.elections.gov.bm or by calling 293- VOTE(8683).

Five people put their names forward on Nomination Day for the Business Councillor contest – current City Councillors Larry Scott, Nicholas Swan, John Harvey and Dennis Tucker - and businessman Michael Branco has joined the race. Business voters will choose four names out of the five to represent them.

City residents are reminded that their four Councillors, as well as the Mayor, have already been determined as they were uncontested on Nomination Day. City residents, therefore, need not attend polling day. The four Residential Councillors will be current Councillors George Scott, Henry Ming, RoseAnn Edwards and newcomer Jenefer Brimmer.

All Councillors, along with Mayor Charles Gosling, will be sworn in on Friday, May 10th at City Hall and begin their three-year term.
