Notice is hereby given that in connection with the staging of the Invitational Front St Mile running races by the BNAA, the following traffic restrictions will be in effect in Hamilton:

ROADS CLOSED

Front Street:

Between Par-La-Ville Road and the foot of Spurling's Hill will be closed to all vehicular traffic from 6:00 pm and will re-open at 11:00 pm

Burnaby Street, Parliament Street, Court Street and King Street

Between Reid and Front Streets will be closed to all vehicular traffic from 6:00 pm and will re-open at 11:00 pm.

NO PARKING

Front Street:

Between Par-La-Ville Road and the foot of Spurlings Hill between 4:00 pm and 11:00 pm

Patrons of businesses along Front Street East are reminded that **ALL VEHICLES MUST BE PROMPTLY REMOVED FROM THAT SECTION OF FRONT STREET BY 4:00 pm**

Burnaby Street: Between Reid and Front Streets from 4:00 pm until 11:00 pm

No. 1 Car Park:

No parking after 2:00 pm, gates will be locked at 4:00 pm and will not open until 11:00 pm

No. 5 Car Park:

No parking after 2:00 pm, access will be closed at 4:00 pm and will not open until 11:00 pm

The Bermuda Police are hereby authorized to close-off streets or portions of streets, restrict and authorize parking as the Commissioner of Police may decide.
