TRAFFIC NOTICE
REMEMBRANCE DAY PARADE

Sunday, 11th November 2018

The City of Hamilton wishes to advise the general public, motorists and businesses that the following road closures and parking restrictions will be in place for the Bermuda Regiment to conduct the Remembrance Day Parade:

Roads Closed – 6:00am to 1:00pm

Front Street from Court Street to Queen Street.
Court Street from Reid Street to Front Street.
Burnaby Street from Reid Street to Front Street.

There will be no parking on those streets for the duration of the Parade.

In addition, No. 1 car park will be closed during the Parade.

Motorists entering the City from the **EAST** are advised to detour up Spurling Hill. Access to stores on Front Street between Spurling's Hill and Fagan's Alley will be allowed. Motorists entering the city from the **WEST** are advised to detour up Queen Street.


In addition, The Bermuda Police Service is authorised to close off streets or portions of streets and authorise parking as the Commissioner of Police decides.
